Activity Name:	Win, Lose or Puck
Number of Participants:	Teams - up to 4
Number of Pucks:	As many as you have
Objective of Activity:	Teamwork, Icebreaker, Fun
Description:	Use the pucks, and only the pucks, to convey the item that is given to the participant. No words, no drawing with hands. Start with physical things (cow, paddle, car etc) then move into concepts (happiness, success, teamwork). Tailor it to the age of the participants.
Activity Name:	Puck Stack
Number of Participants:	5 per group, more if you want
Number of Pucks:	As many as you have (towers past 30 usually tip)
Objective of Activity:	Teamwork, Inclusion, Problem Solving
Description:	Stack the pucks as tall as you can - try single stacks or stacks with a wider base.
Activity Name:	Roll To Know
Number of Participants:	Up to 20
Number of Pucks:	1, 2 or 3 your choice
Objective of Activity:	Icebreaker, Fun
Description:	Sitting in a circle, roll the puck from person to person, with each new person answering a question. You say who you are rolling it to, if it goes to the right person then they answer a question, if not you answer another one.

Activity Name:	Juggle The Puck
Number of Participants:	Groups of 10
Number of Pucks:	1 puck per person
Objective of Activity:	Icebreaker, Teamwork, Problem solving
Description:	<p>The group starts with one puck and passes it to someone else in the group. That person passes it to someone else so on and so forth. The group decides on the best method for passing the pucks - underhand, rolling, sliding along floor. The goal is to add more pucks and keep them going in the same pattern.</p> <p>You can also have them each try to pass the pucks at the same time. At first throw to the person to your left and get from the person to your right - then try and skip people.</p> <p>For another activity you can have each person stand on their puck and then have the entire group change places at the same time.</p>
Activity Name:	Puck Them All?
Number of Participants:	Up to 10
Number of Pucks:	All that you have
Objective of Activity:	Creative Solutions, Problem Solving, Teamwork
Description:	Have a member of your team carry all the pucks from point A to point B. How many team members can move the pucks from point A to point B and back in a set time period?
Activity Name:	Puck Drop
Number of Participants:	Groups of up to 5
Number of Pucks:	One puck per group
Objective of Activity:	Problem Solving, Creative Solutions, Teamwork
Description:	Place an item on the floor. Have the group drop the puck from a pre-determined height and land closest to the item on the floor. For additional difficulty you can have the item on the floor be another puck and they have to get the dropped puck to land on top of the other puck.

Activity Name:	3-5-7 Team Style
Number of Participants:	Two Teams
Number of Pucks:	15
Objective of Activity:	Problem Solving, Group Decision Making, Teamwork
Description:	Pile pucks into three piles - a pile of 3, a pile of 5 and a pile of 7. The object of the game is to have the other team pick up the last puck left. The rules are that during your turn you are allowed to pick up as many or as few pucks from one pile as you want - but you have to take at least one puck each turn. The team that picks up the last puck loses.
Activity Name:	Stable Tower of Puck
Number of Participants:	Two Teams
Number of Pucks:	25 for each team
Objective of Activity:	Teamwork, Creative Solutions, Problem Solving
Description:	To work together as a team to build a tower of pucks that the other team cannot knock down. Have them plan
Activity Name:	Puck Island
Number of Participants:	5 to 15
Number of Pucks:	Many
Objective of Activity:	Teamwork, Problem Solving, Creative Solutions
Description:	Get your team from point A to point B with the group only touching pucks when in the center zone.
